Exchange students are only accepted based on a nomination by the home institution. Partner institution should send the nomination letter containing student's name, gender, field and level of study and planned duration of study period (semester or full academic year) and his/her e-mail address, as well as the other documents required by the receiving institution, to [mobility@ni.ac.rs](mailto:mobility@ni.ac.rs)

### Serbian Language Courses:

Serbian courses are organized at the Center for Serbian as a Foreign and the Second Language (<https://centar.filfak.ni.ac.rs/en/>) operating within the Department of Serbian Language of the Faculty of Philosophy in Niš.

The Center offers different levels of courses and its program is intended for:

**Decision Response:** As receiving institution the University of Niš will send its decision within 4 weeks.

**Transcript of Records:** A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than five weeks after the assessment period has finished.

**Termination of Agreement:** A unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 November 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
