On May 11, 2023, ICSPU proudly became home to the Orange Digital Centre (Visit Us at <https://digitalcenter.orange.md/>), part of a global program launched by the Orange Group, which enhances digital literacy in each country it operates. Following the establishment of Orange Digital Centres in countries like Belgium, Luxembourg, Poland, France, Egypt, Tunisia, and Jordan, Moldova now joins this prestigious network. The Orange Digital Centre serves as a lifelong learning hub, empowering individuals of all ages—children, youth, students, women, entrepreneurs, and seniors—to unlock their potential and enhance their professional skills for the jobs of tomorrow.

The Orange Digital Centre features three core components that offer free access to valuable resources:

Programming School: Here, children take their first steps in coding, women develop essential digital skills and entrepreneurship knowledge, while youth explore creative IT projects.

Fab Lab: This digital fabrication workshop enables both young people and adults to bring their ideas to life by creating tangible objects using advanced technologies and digital fabrication techniques.

Entrepreneurial School: Participants learn the ins and outs of launching a startup, including the essential stages of project development, empowering them to launch their own initiatives right here in Moldova.

Additionally, the ICSPU Students and Alumni Association (ASA) was established in March 2021 and has actively participated in numerous initiatives and projects, including the Ion Creanga Mini-Park and the EcoCampus Project, which emerged as a winner in the “Opportunities for My University” competition promoted and funded by the ICSPU administration.
